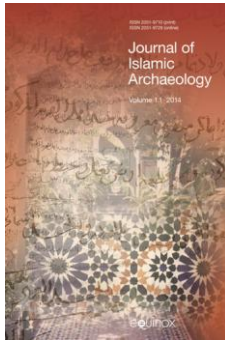


YOUR PROFESSOR

PREREQUISITES

The program is open for students who have finished a **B.A. program in Islamic Studies, Art History, Archaeology** or similar subjects.

Knowledge of Middle Eastern languages (Arabic, Persian, Turkish) is recommended but not compulsory. Language courses can also be used as Electives.
